# Principal's address

The Principal welcomed the gathering and extended a warm welcome to the parents for the meeting which was being held in an online mode. She prayed for the safety of everyone through the intercession of our patron Saint St. Francis Xavier. She emphasized the vital role of the Parent-Teacher Association in the college mission of serving the society in the field of education. She stressed the fact that the PTA is a combination of the most resourceful stakeholders of this institution, and this meeting is a step in the direction in forming the new PTA of our college. She mentioned the precautionary measures undertaken by the college during the time of Covid-19.

She informed the gathering of the measures adopted by the College to promoted effective learning. Adding that 2000 students had been admitted to the college, she stressed that the college was keeping steady in its ideal of forming integrated individuals. She said that soon different cells will be formed and will organize webinars, debates and various other activities online for students. The Principal also informed the audience of the 'A Grade' awarded to the college by NAAC.

A two-minute silence was observed to pray for the departed souls of our T. Y. B. Sc. Electronics student, Alfred Dias, and Mr. Avelino Fernandes, father of the Chairperson, Dr. Greta Costa.

### Reading and approval of Minutes of previous meeting

Ms. Vilma Fernandes, the Secretary of the PTA, read the minutes of the previous meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2018. Ms. Prajoti Chimulkar proposed the minutes and Mr. Mahesh Nair seconded it, following which the minutes were adopted by the House.

#### **Reading and approval of Accounts**

Ms. Sumina D'Costa, the Treasurer, read the audited statement of PTA accounts. The Chairperson requested the members to propose the audited statement of accounts, to which Ms. Zarina Chawdari proposed the audited statement of the PTA accounts and Ms. Aquilla Afonso seconded it. The accounts were then, adopted by the House.

#### Matters arising therefrom

The Chairperson invited suggestions from the members under, Matters arising therefrom. There were no discussions or amendments.

#### **Resource person speaks**

The Resource person, Dr. Apurva Kamat, who is a medical Officer at UHC Mapusa addressed the gathering. She gave an insight about Covid-19 and Coronavirus. She specified the common symptoms of COVID 19 which includes cough, sneezing, running nose, rash, and diarrhea. She also mentioned that hygiene should be maintained, and the mask should be worn properly and not below the nose or on the chin. She laid emphasis on frequent washing of hands, which is necessary as our hands get contaminated as we have a habit of touching our mouth while sneezing and coughing. Then, she gave a demonstration on how to wear a mask and wash our hands with clean water frequently for 20 seconds. She also said that there is no restriction with regards to the use of warm water, bar soap/ liquid. She said anything can be used but preferably, an alcohol-based sanitizer should be used.

She also mentioned about the tests that are undertaken to test coronavirus. If found positive, depending on the criticality, the patient is kept in home isolation or may be hospitalized. If home isolated then, the concerned person should be on a good diet, avoid smoking and alcohol consumption and maintain hygiene, which can prevent further risks.

She also spoke about the importance of Plasma Donation. She mentioned that it is beneficial to both, the donor as well as the beneficiary. She also mentioned that after the recovery the concerned person who was tested positive should take necessary precautions and continue breathing exercises, avoid crowded places, wear masks and maintain social distancing. Lastly, she advised to be smart and alert by avoiding rumors and to stay safe.

#### Administrator's address

The Administrator, Fr. Tony Salema, addressed the gathering and appreciated the presence of the parents, the teaching staff and the organizers of the General body meeting. He also further appreciated the support of parents and teachers towards the betterment of the teaching and learning process. Further, he said we would continue to provide support and a helping hand in whatever way possible.
