	Dr. Suhas spoke about his career experience, each of his

	participants. He highlighted the main research activities of NIO.
	The work done and the procedures adopted to carry out ocean
	research was captivating. It was interesting to know about all
	the major problems in the ocean which arise by things we
	would consider small, like change in pH and change in
	temperature, leading to ocean deoxygenation leading to
	several marine life getting affected. He shared how he has
	created future pH conditions artificially in his laboratory. The
	work carried out involving aquatic life forms was mesmerising.
	The different sea vessels they venture into for their
	expeditions, the living conditions endured, was listed by Dr.
	Suhas. On being requested to throw some light on the
	difficulties faced aboard, Dr. Suhas replied that it's the
	temperature difference, adding that the cruise members
	undergo rigorous training before setting out into the sea. He
	said that it's a blessing to have a job one can enjoy, stating that
	he has the liberty to experiment what he wants to and that he
	dares to thread the untrodden path.

Outcome of Event	The students got an insight into the activities carried out at NIO. They were also exposed to Marine Science as a Career alternative.


