Report	<p>The Orientation Program for the First-Year students, the students were accompanied by their parent or a guardian. The program began at 9am with a short invocation led by Ms. Eweny Fernandes, faculty, department of BCA, which was followed by the singing of the college anthem. The Administrator of the college, Rev. Fr. Antonio Salema, delivered the welcome address. The Principal, Ms. Ursula Barretto, in her address, encouraged the students to prioritize their academics as well as participate in the various co-circular activities. She highlighted the role of the faculty as facilitators and urged the students to interact with them. She thanked the parents for entrusting their child to the college, emphasized their role as parents, urged them to be in touch with the faculty to monitor the progress of their child and encouraged them to be active members of the PTA.</p> <p>Ms. Charmaine Dias, faculty, department of BBA, was the compere for the event. Ms. Ursula, highlighted the Vision, Mission, college motto, emblem and the accreditations of the college. She then briefed them about the college campus, the courses offered, the various features of the college such as career guidance, counselling services, mentor mentee programme, out station study trips, value education, placement cell and extension activities related to various cells and clubs.</p>

	<p>Stating the hard work and discipline is the sure road to success, Ms. Ursula informed the audience of the rules and regulations of the college. She urged the parents and students to read the rules and regulations on the handbook and be aware of the disciplinary actions that could be taken. She emphasized the wearing of ID cards, maintaining overall 75% attendance and 50% in individual papers. She also stressed on the importance of anti-ragging and stated that all students are responsible to the Principal, Administrator and staff. She wished the students a meaningful, fruitful, enjoyable and growth filled years at S. Xavier's College.</p> <p>Ms. Vailarose Fernandes, faculty, department of Mass Communication and Journalism, briefed the audience about the key features of the UGC Curriculum and Credit Framework for Under graduate Programme, under National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. She highlighted the Programme structure, the courses the students will undertake in Semester I and II, the working of the credit system and the credit requirements.</p> <p>Dr. Santana Fernandes, presented an overview of the Scheme of Examination under NEP, highlighting that evaluation under NEP is based on continuous assessment comprising of Intra Semester Assessment (ISA) and Semester End Examination (SEA). She informed the eligibility conditions to be fulfilled to appear for the SEA and stated that there is a separate head of passing for all courses with theory and practical components.</p> <p>Ms. Dakshata Zambulkar, introduced the audience to the St. Xavier's College Library, its facilities, services and rules. Mr. Roger Fernandes, Instructor, Department of Physical Education and Sports, offered an outline of the sports facilities of the college, the various University sports activities that the students can participate in, the benefits of participation and the sports entitlement marks.</p> <p>Mr. Stalin D'Sa, Convenor of the Cultural Committee, presented the cultural activities of the college, the clubs and cells and urged the students to participate in events organized by the college, especially 'Plus Points' as well as the various intercollegiate events.</p> <p>Ms. Sampada Naik, NCC Cadet, presented a summary of the activities of the NCC girls and boys battalion and the benefits of joining the National Cadet Corps and Dr. Rheanne Da Silva, Programme Officer, National Service Scheme offered a glimpse of the activities undertaken by the NSS volunteers and detailed the entitlement marks for participation as an NSS volunteer in various events.</p> <p>The program ended at 11:30 am with the students filling out the anti-ragging forms.</p>
