Report	Objectives: To understand the importance as well as to practice dental hygiene
	Outcome: Reducing dental problems/ issues among the youth
	The Department of Economics, in collaboration with the Health and
	Wellness Club of St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, Goa, organised an
	insightful talk on oral health on the 22nd of August, 2024. Dr.
	Gretchen Pinto, the resource person, a seasoned dental practitioner with
	28 years of experience, is an alumna of St. Xavier's Higher Secondary
	School and a graduate of Goa Dental College. Dr. Pinto began her talk
	by explaining the different types of teeth and their functions,
	emphasising the importance of each in maintaining one's overall oral
	health. She then discussed the formation of cavities, how they spread,
	and the various treatment options available. The session also covered
	common gum diseases and the advantages and disadvantages of tooth
	extraction. Furthermore, Dr. Pinto delved into the causes of mouth
	ulcers, providing practical examples and spoke about the factors that
	lead to the buildup of plaque and tartar. She also highlighted the
	essential tools for maintaining good oral hygiene, offered valuable tips
	on proper oral care and discussed habits that contribute to poor oral
	health. The talk also included a discussion on foods that are harmful to
	teeth, underlining the importance of a balanced diet in maintaining oral

	health. The session concluded with a brief question-and-answer segment, where Dr. Pinto addressed various queries from the audience, further enriching their understanding of oral health. The talk was well-received by the 124 attendees from FYBA, SYBA, TYBA, SYBCOM
	and TYBCOM, leaving them with a deeper understanding of the importance of oral hygiene and practical steps to maintain it.
