




STUDENTS COUNCIL ELECTONS 2024-25

4. Students are informed to collect the Identity Card from the College Office. Original ID card is compulsory for Voting. Students are also requestd to read the **VOTER'S GUIDELINES** which will be displayed on the Notice Board and Website.

STUDENTS COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2024-25


1. Elections for General Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Sports Secretary and Ladies representative are scheduled for 28th August 2024, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Elections will be conducted in the College Seminar Hall.
2. The Class Representative elections will be held on 29th August 2024, in the respective class rooms as per the Time table and schedule. Refer to the website and student Council notice boards for further details.
3. The elections to the Students Council is through a secret ballot.
4. Students are expected to read and understand the Election Guidelines.

Guidelines for Voters during Student Council Elections 2024-2025


1. Students are requested to check their Serial No. on the Voter's List which is displayed at the College Website and the Notice Board outside the Seminar Hall.
2. Students who have enrolled and paid admission fees on or before the 1st working day of August shall be included in the voter's list.
3. The voter shall note the scheduled date, time, and venue for casting their vote.
4. The voter shall co-operate to ensure peaceful and orderly polling. The voter has complete freedom to cast their vote without being subjected to annoyance or obstruction.
5. Respect the Electoral Process during the elections. Voters are not allowed to carry recording device , mobile phones to the **POLLING BOOTH**.
6. Carry proof of Original Identity hard copy only (college ID card or fee receipt in case of First Year students not receiving their ID cards).
7. There shall be no voting by proxy.
8. Only women voters shall vote for the post of Ladies Representative (**LR**).
9. A ballot paper shall be issued to a voter on production of a college ID card and signing against their name in the voters' list.
10. While casting your vote for GS, CS, SS, and LR, a female voter will be given 04 different coloured ballot papers for the respective 04 Executive Committee posts. A male voter will be given 3 ballots only. (please refer to Guideline number 8)
11. The coloured ballot papers shall be folded by the voter and dropped in the ballot box identical to the coloured ballot paper.

12. A ballot paper shall be rejected as void if it bears any mark or writing by which the vote can be identified.
13. A voter shall mark a cross (X) in the box on the ballot paper against the name of the candidate to whom they intend to give a vote. (Please refer to the two specimen copies attached).
14. A vote shall be rejected as void if the mark indicating the vote is placed in such a manner as to create doubt about which candidate the vote has been given.
15. No ballot paper shall be issued to any voter after the hour fixed for closing the poll except those voters who are present at the polling station at the time of closing the poll.
16. The voter shall not indulge in any activities that violate the Code of Conduct. Those who do shall be dealt with strict disciplinary action deemed fit by the College authorities.
17. The voter shall accept and respect the final results of the election.
18. The voter shall support the elected candidate and work together to promote the intellectual, social, and cultural development of the students of the College.
