	Key Highlights of the Talk:
	Introduction to Overseas Education: Ms. Gayatri D'Silva opened the talk by introducing the concept of overseas education and explaining its advantages. 	Popular Study Destinations: Ms. D'Silva provided detailed insights into various countries that are popular among international students. She gave a
