The theme chosen by the UNWTO for this year 2024-25 was "Tourism and peace ". The aim of the event was to enhance students understanding of travel and tourism and to come up with new ideas to support peaceful and eco-friendly tourism.</p> <p>The preparation for the event started way back in July, wherein the students were divided into seven different teams such as HR, Logistics, Rounds, Hospitality, Deco, Finance and Marketing. All these teams were led by their individual co-coordinators followed by the student event coordinator Dave Sherwin D'Souza from Third Year. The students of First year, Second Year and Third Year played a crucial role in ensuring the success of the event by coordinating with each team and working effortlessly in the preparation.</p> <p>Many colleges from across Goa were invited, colleges were given pre-round assignments where in teams had to put in their efforts to qualify for final day of event. On the day of the event five colleges qualified to participate in this event, showcasing their talents and knowledge related to tourism and peace. All these colleges were given five different team names like "The Rising Dragons", "The Wildfire Warriors", "The Frostbite Fighters", "The Euro Titans", and "The Aussie Thunder" to compete in the rounds.</p> <p>The event was held in college seminar hall and started at 8.00 am with registration of teams.
