	The inaugural session began with a lecture by Dr V. Ramanathan on
	"Scientific Temper Entailed in Bharatiya Pramāṇa-śāstra: Beyond Darśana". He demonstrated quotations from Indian philosophical texts
	which have scientific content. Dr. Venketeswara Pai presented on
	"Development of systems of numeration in Indian astronomical
	context". He took a practical session wherein the audience calculated
	based on aphorisms found in the ancient mathematical texts.
	"Ānandavardhana's Dhvanyāloka: semiotic analysis in Indian
	Knowledge Tradition" was the title of the session conducted by Dr.
	Prasad Ramesh Bhide. He discussed at length the aphorisms of
	semantics and introduced Indian aesthetics.
