<b>Report</b>	<p>School of Sanskrit, Philosophy, and Indic Studies, Goa University in association with Indian Council of Philosophical Research, New Delhi and Philosophical Association, Goa organised a one-day state level seminar titled, "Delving Deep into the Indian Knowledge Systems" to celebrate 'Indian Philosophers Day 2024', on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2024 at the Seminar Hall of Faculty Block "B" of Goa University from 9.30 am to 4.30 pm. The eminent speakers of the day were, Dr V. Ramanathan, Dr Venketeswara Pai R and Dr Prasad Ramesh Bhide.</p> <p>The inaugural session began with a lecture by Dr V. Ramanathan on "Scientific Temper Entailed in Bharatiya Pramāṇa-śāstra: Beyond Darśana". He demonstrated quotations from Indian philosophical texts which have scientific content. Dr. Venketeswara Pai presented on "Development of systems of numeration in Indian astronomical context". He took a practical session wherein the audience calculated based on aphorisms found in the ancient mathematical texts. "Ānandavardhana's Dhvanyāloka: semiotic analysis in Indian Knowledge Tradition" was the title of the session conducted by Dr. Prasad Ramesh Bhide. He discussed at length the aphorisms of semantics and introduced Indian aesthetics.</p> <p>The half day seminar was attended by Dr Shefali Kale, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Philosophy, St Xavier's College and three students of FYBA Philosophy, Ms Anshika Thakur, Ms Rimi Mahadeshwar and Ms Paroma Kulkarni.</p>
