<b>Report</b>	<p><b>Objectives:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To protect and conserve the environment</li> <li>2. To create awareness about E-waste management</li> <li>3. To encourage various stakeholders from the college to dispose obsolete E-waste to authorised dealers.</li> </ol> <p><b>Brief Description:</b> To commemorate International E-waste day on 14<sup>th</sup> October, a talk was held on the topic “Reboot the Earth” by Mr. Ashley Delaney, the resource person. Two sessions were held at 9:30-10:30 am and 10:45-11:45 am for college students on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2024.</p> <p>Mr. Ashley began the sessions explaining the various types of wastes. He emphasized the need to segregate garbage from E-waste and give it to authorised recycling dealers so that it can be adequately recycled. He mentioned that when E-waste is given to unauthorized dealers, not all metals are retrieved that can be reused.</p>

	<p>Besides, he stated that when E-waste is not recycled scientifically, it puts life of the individual and community at risk. The key points stressed upon was, “Waste is not garbage, instead a resource that can be used again and again.” To make his sessions interactive he conducted spot questions and prizes were given for the right responses. At the end of the sessions, students were informed about the E-waste collection drive beginning on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 and ending on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2024.</p> <p>The drive invoked a positive response (generating 114 kgs of E-waste) from the students, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. Mr. Ashley Delaney arranged for a free pickup on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2024.</p> <p><b>Outcomes:</b> 1. Students became aware of the need to conserve and protect the environment  2. Students were sensitised on ways to manage E-waste scientifically  3. Stakeholders adopted measures to dispose obsolete E-waste to authorised dealers contributing towards a greener planet and circular economy</p> <p><b>Number of Beneficiaries:</b> A total of 130 students attended both the sessions.</p>
