Report	REPORT OF THE SESSION ON 'CULTIVATING A RESEARCH
	MINDSET: STRATEGIES AND RESOURCES FOR COLLEGE
	EDUCATORS' HELD AT ST. XAVIER'S COLLEGE MAPUSA
	The Department of Sociology, in collaboration with IQAC and the Research
	and Development Cell, organized a session on 'Cultivating a Research
	Mindset: Strategies and Resources for College Educators at St. Xavier's
	College Mapusa Goa. The session was held on 20 th September, 2024 in the Seminar hall.
	The resource person for the event was Prof. Savio Falleiro, Managing Director
	of Goa State Research Foundation. The Principal Ms. Ursula Barreto, Vice
	Principal Ms. Sandra Fernandes, Fr. Antonio Salema, the Administrator, the
	IQAC coordinator Dr. Ubaldina Noronha, and Prof. Janet Fernandes, the
	Convenor of Research and Development cell attended the same.
	The session began at around 12:30 pm with Ms. Freda Tavares Assistant
	Professor in Sociology addressing the resource person. Further on a brief
	introduction of the resource person was given by Prof. Afonso Botelho HOD
	of Sociology. A potted plant was presented to the speaker by the Principal. The
	session was further taken over by Prof. Falleiro providing insights on
	conducting research and its importance.
	The resource person also emphasised the importance of providing educators
	with a deeper foundation in the field of research. Prof. Falleiro also provided
	some enlightening thoughts on how to build research habits, particularly for
	new educators. Some suggested strategies include reading often, attending workshops, understanding research topics, and learning data analysis tools.
	Prof. Falleiro provided some basic guidance to novice educators on how to
	conduct research by finding themes through reading PhD thesis available on
	shodhganga.
	Prof. Falleiro also informed the faculty about the existence of counterfeit or
	fake academic journals, often referred to as "cloned" or "predatory" journals
	and emphasized to have publications in Scopus and UGC Carelist Journals. He
	and emphasized to have publications in scopus and OOC Carenst Journals. He

	also highlighted some of the schemes available for teachers in order to conduct their research such as Minor research project, Major projects, Doctoral fellowship, Post doctoral fellowship and Interdisciplinary research intervention scheme for local development (IRIS-ID) for PhD holders at GSRF. Some of the other initiatives provided by GSRF are workshops organized for Post Graduate and Third Year students to conduct research through video series by renowned personalities. The session ended with a vote of thanks delivered by Assistant Professor Elizabeth Bara.
