Report	Brief description:				
	The Department of Botany celebrated 'World Coconut Day' on				
	18th September, 2024 under the DBT Star College scheme. On this				
	occasion, a lecture by Dr. V. Arunachalam on "Coconut for				
	Circular Economy, building partnerships: Sharing Experiences and				
	Coconut management Practices" was held. Various competitions				
	for the students were organized, too.				
	The program began with a prayer followed by the watering of the				
	plant- a symbolic gesture to convey the message of preserving and				
	protecting the environment. The dignitaries on the dais included				
	the Principal Ms. Ursula Barreto, the Administrator Fr. Antonio				
	Salema, Vice Principal Ms. Sandra Fernandes, the chief guest Dr.				
	Arunachalam and the Head of the Department Dr. Wendy Martins.				
	The Principal Ms. Barreto in her welcome address appreciated the				
	initiative of the Department of Botany and spoke on the coconut				
	tree as 'The Kalpa Vruksha'				
	Dr. V. Arunachalam, Principal scientist from ICAR, Old Goa				
	spoke on coconut plantation practices, intercrop for coconuts and				
	the diseases affecting coconuts. He also mentioned about various				
	apps namely Coconut Expert System which could help the farmers.				
	Dr. Arunachalam also gave the names and brief idea on coconut				
	entrepreneurs who could help in mentoring those interested in				
	coconut plantations and entrepreneurships. He also explained				
	'circular economy' where materials never become waste and nature				
	is regenerated.				
	After the lecture/talk a short documentary titled 'Coco Film' was				

	shown to the audience by Dr. Maria Augusta D'Souza. A well-presented dance "Kotteo Fuggdeo" was performed by the students and coordinated by Dr. Seema Fernandes Various competitions like poster competition titled 'Coconut Tree-A Gift to Humanity', a 'Coco Art'- Wealth out of Waste' and 'Cocolicious Food' evoked excellent responses from students. Few students had also set up stalls to sell dishes made from coconut. An exhibition on coconut and various artefacts made from the coconut tree was showcased. The program ended with a prize distribution for the winners of the various competitions and vote of thanks by the Head of the Department, Dr. Wendy Martins.
