It served as a reminder to the citizens about their rights, duties, and freedoms given by the constitution, further strengthening India's democracy, fostering awareness of these values and principles.

The Quiz was held online via Google Form. Total number of questions were 30 in the form objective nature, statements, Audio/Video and True/False. Participants were required to complete this Quiz within 45 minutes. Each Question carried 1 mark, those who score 60% and above have been provided with E-certificates. The Quiz was open for the students and general public.

With the participation of students and general public from the state as well as the across the country have fostered a sense of unity and shared responsibility for democratic values.

Outcomes:

- Participants gained a deeper understanding of the Indian Constitution, particularly its core principles of justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.
- 2. Participants became more aware of their rights, responsibilities, and the values enshrined in the Constitution.
- 3. Reciting the Preamble allowed participants to connect with the foundational values of India's democratic system, such as justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity.
