To understand the need to protect and preserve the environment.</li> </ol> <p><b>Brief Description:</b> The Department of Political Science organised a Field Trip to Strawberry Farm and a trek to Waterfall, Netravalli, on 16th March 2025, for the students of the department. The trip commenced at 8:30 from Mapusa bus stand and reached the Strawberry Farm, Netravalli, at 12:30pm. The students got an opportunity to observe and appreciate local initiatives to generate income in an</p>

The students and faculty had to walk through vegetation and descend steps to reach the waterfall. On reaching the waterfall students had a refreshing experience with the surroundings for around 2 hours. Before leaving the students ensured that there was no litter thrown around. Waste was picked up and disposed in allotted spaces by the governmental agencies.</p> <p>The faculty and students then returned to their destination at round 8:00pm.
