Report	<p>REPORT ON INTER-COLLEGIATE QUIZ AND POSTER-MAKING COMPETITION</p> <p>St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, in collaboration with the District Tobacco Control Cell, North Goa, organized an Inter-Collegiate Quiz and Poster-Making Competition on 18th March 2025 at the State Institute of Health and Family Welfare, Mapusa. Prof. Afonso Botelho, Nodal Officer, Anti Tobacco Campaign was assisted in this endeavour by the Department of Sociology. The event aimed to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco consumption and promote a healthier lifestyle among students.</p> <p>A total of 16 colleges from across Goa participated in the event.
