Their plan focused on fostering technological innovation and environmental sustainability to build a resilient and progressive future. Their budget emphasized key sectors such as education, healthcare, energy, tourism while maintaining fiscal responsibility. They stated that the Expenditure Priorities in their Ideal Budget would be 1. Education & Skill Development 2. Power & Energy 3. Healthcare 4. Tourism 5. Public Safety. 6. Salaries & Pensions. The Budget would focus on 1. Healthcare Access: Expansion of healthcare facilities, workforce, AI-driven diagnostics. 2. Waste Management: Investment in disposal infrastructure, zerowaste initiatives, and monitoring frameworks. 3. Sustainability Initiatives: Encouraging sustainable businesses, green architecture, and renewable energy projects. 4. Business & FDI: Supporting eco-friendly enterprises, improving infrastructure, and facilitating investments. 5. Agriculture Support: Providing subsidies for irrigation, seeds, modern farming techniques. Special Provisions would be made for 1. Water Harvesting 2. Ecosystem Restoration 3. Disaster Forecasting 4. Hinterland Tourism Research
