Report	<p style="text-align: center;">Jodhpur - Sam Sand Dunes - Jaisalmer - Jaipur (07N / 08 D)</p> <p>The Department of BBA (Travel & Tourism) conducted study tour to Rajasthan, encompassing Jodhpur, Sam Sand Dunes, Jaisalmer, and Jaipur, provided an enriching travel experience, immersing participants in the rich cultural and historical fabric of India. Departing from Goa's Margao Railway Station in the early hours of October 27, the group arrived in Jodhpur the following morning and began exploring its majestic sights. Highlights included the towering Mehrangarh Fort, the peaceful Jaswant Thada, and the royal Umaid Bhavan. The day concluded with free time for shopping, allowing everyone to experience local Rajasthani handicrafts. Next day after check out the tour moved to the enchanting Sam Sand Dunes, where students experienced the desert landscape with Jeep Safari, camel ride and evening folk music and dance, which brought a unique touch of Rajasthani culture.</p> <p>The journey continued with a visit to Jaisalmer's historical landmarks, such as the Jaisalmer Fort, Patwon Ki Haveli, and Gadisar Lake, offering insights into Rajasthan's architectural legacy. Afterward, the group traveled overnight to Jaipur, arriving early on October 31. Sightseeing in Jaipur featured the Birla Temple, Hawa Mahal, Amer Fort, and Jal Mahal, presenting the architectural marvels of the Pink City. November 1, checkout from hotel and return journey the group departed from Jaipur for Goa. This immersive week-long experience, filled with historical visits, local culture, and scenic beauty, offered participants valuable insights into Rajasthan's heritage and left lasting memories to cherish.
