The event commenced with the Alumni Lecture Series by, Dr. Shraddha Shrikant Naik, alumnus of the Political Science department, who spoke on 'Research in Political Science'. 	Thereafter began distribution of the certificates for the 30 hours course 'Civic Engagement: Empowering Citizens', conducted by the Department of Political Science. This was followed by a prize distribution ceremony awarding the participants for their hard work and exuberant participation. The event ended with the vote of thanks.
	After the Alumni lecture series began the on-stage and off-stage events for the students to share their knowledge and talent in the context of politics. The on-stage events included a role play on various political figures around the world, reflecting on their personality, beliefs, and legacy during that era. There was also a skit competition on the theme 'Gender Equality' highlighting the issues relating to gender inequality throughout the history. The final on-stage event was a fashion show displaying a fusion of world cultures and the creative fashion skills of the students. The off-stage events included a quiz, a reel making competition that exhibited the students' political awareness of the world. The students also showcased their artistic side in a cartooning, and rangoli competition focusing on the themes of political leaders and feminism respectively.
