Report	On August 15, 2024, the college commemorated India's 78 th Independence Day. The program began at 9:00 a.m. with the cadets accompanying all dignitaries, including college administrator Rev. Fr. Antonio Salema, Principal Ms. Ursula Barreto, Vice-Principal Ms. Sandra Fernandes, and the in-charge officers of NCC girls, NCC boys, and NSS, to the flag hoisting area. The flag hoisting was followed by singing of the National Anthem. The Girl's Battalion was then led in the march-past by SUO. Tanisha Palyekar, followed by NCC boys Bn and NSS volunteers. First and foremost, the Administrator formally welcomed the gathering with an uplifting address. Subsequently, Mr. Stephen Fernandes, TYBCom student, offered student speech, followed by faculty member Dr. B. C. Nair, HoD Mathematics, who expressed his ideas on nation's progress throughout the previous 78 years. This was followed by release of various departmental newsletters and book published by Prof Nelson Lobo. The principal then gave her speech, emphasizing the need of sustainability and ecological conservation for the future. She extended her congratulations to

	all the cadets, athletes, and meritorious postgraduate students who received recognition from the college on this special day. The Independence Day event featured a variety of cultural elements presented by NCC cadets and NSS volunteers, including a nationalistic dance, patriotic song, and street play emphasizing the Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan.
