Report	On January 6, 2025, St. Xavier's College hosted an enlightening session on the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), led by Mr. Afaq Ajim Aga, an ACCA Affiliate. The event aimed to educate students on the significance of ACCA as a globally recognized professional qualification and its careerenhancing opportunities. There were 74 students who participated in the talk. The session started with a very warm gesture by Ms. Vidisha Singh, who presented a potted plant to Mr. Aga as a welcome gesture. This gesture was very thoughtful and symbolic of growth and knowledge. Mr. Aga then delivered an engaging presentation on the structure and benefits of the ACCA qualification. He highlighted its global recognition in 180+ countries and its focus on professional ethics, practical experience, and advanced accounting knowledge. The speaker explained in detail the ACCA routes after Class 10, 12, or graduation and talked on the exemptions that are given to St.
	graduation and talked on the exemptions that are given to St. Xavier's graduates. He outlined the core areas that are addressed in

	the curriculum of ACCA in financial management, taxation, and strategic reporting and also mentioned how it is flexible and directly relevant to one's career. Mr. Aga further went on to explain the need for practical experience to obtain ACCA membership. The session included an interactive Q&A segment where students explored topics such as ACCA's role in international careers and its advantages compared to other accounting qualifications. Mr. Aga's responses further clarified how ACCA could open doors to global roles in fields such as auditing, financial analysis, and investment banking. The event concluded with Ms. Charbel D'souza delivering a heartfelt vote of thanks. She expressed gratitude to the speaker for his valuable insights, the coordinator of the talk Ms. Sumina da Costa, the organizing team for their efforts and the students for their active participation. The session was highly appreciated by the attendees, leaving them motivated to consider ACCA as a pathway to achieving their professional goals.
