Report	A session on "Substance Abuse: Its Impact on Mental Health" was conducted by Ms. Elvira Pereira, Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology, St. Xavier's College on 9th September 2024 at Kripa Foundation, Anjuna. The session aimed to create awareness about the psychological consequences of substance use and foster mental health literacy among the participants. Ms. Pereira addressed the physiological and psychological effects of various substances, including alcohol, nicotine, cannabis, and synthetic drugs. She highlighted how substance abuse can lead to mood disorders, anxiety, psychosis, and cognitive impairments. Drawing from real-life cases and psychological theories, she provided an engaging overview of how addiction disrupts emotional regulation, decision-making, and interpersonal relationships. Interactive in nature, the session included discussions, reflective questions, and personal sharing from the participants, making it both informative and therapeutic. Emphasis was also placed on the importance of early intervention, support systems, and the role of rehabilitation centers in restoring mental well-being.
