A Guest Lecture - 'Revisiting Freedom: An Appreciation of The Aesthetics Of Ambedkarism': The lecture was held in collaboration with Museum of Goa (MOG) on 21st August 2024. The objective of the lecture was to introduce students to Dalit history through experiences narrated by Dalit writer, Mr. Siddhesh Gautam. Mr. Gautam shared his journey, and struggles with ostracism, discrimination, caste identity and acceptance. He drew inspiration from the life of B.R. Ambedkar and revealed that Ambedkar's writings influenced his art. Mr. Gautam emphasized the need for equality, acceptance, and social justice, highlighting the contributions of Dalits to Indian society and the economy. The event concluded with a Q&A session. 8 faculty and 47 students attended the event, which was coordinated by Ms. Alice D'Cruz and Ms. Eden Fernandes.

Talk - Understanding Research Ethics: A session on "Understanding Research Ethics" by Ms. Dakshata Zambulkar, Librarian, for TYBA English Literature project students was organized on 26th August 2024. The session aimed to enhance students' understanding of research, methodology, and ethics. She also introduced e-resources, such as Delnet and N-List, to aid research. The session was attended by 17 students and 5 teachers, and was coordinated by Dr. Prema Rocha.

Lit Quiz 3.0 - 'Learn, Grow and Conquer': The 3rd edition of Lit. Quiz was organized on 5th October 2024, following a preliminary written round on 1st October. The coordinator for the Quiz was Dr. Maria Claudette Gomes while Mr. Christie Fernandes (TYBA Honours English) was the Quizmaster. 18 teams of three students each competed, with the top four advancing to the finals. The quiz featured six rounds: General Literary Trivia, Syllabus Specific, Book Covers, First Lines, Poetry, and Comics. 


ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED
