Report	The Department of Konkani at St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, in collaboration
	with Goa Konkani Academy, Panjim, and Rosary College, Navelim, organized
	a one-day workshop on 10th January 2025. The workshop, held from 9:00 AM
	to 4:00 PM at the Conference Hall of the PG Block, focused on training
	students in writing various forms of Konkani literature, including poetry, story,
	children's literature, and literary criticism. The inaugural session featured Ms.
	Prashanti Thalpankar, Associate Professor and noted Konkani writer from
	DMC College, as the Chief Guest. Other dignitaries present were Ms. Ursula
	Barreto, Principal of St. Xavier's College; Mr. Vasant Sawant, President of Goa
	Konkani Academy; Mr. Dharma Chodankar, Head of the Konkani Department
	at St. Xavier's College; and Dr. Fr. Luis Gomes, the program convenor.
	The sessions provided hands-on training in different forms of Konkani
	literature. Mr. Prakash Naik, coordinated by Ms. Anikita Zambaulikar, led the
	session on poetry, guiding students in crafting poems with creativity and
	cultural depth. The session on story writing, coordinated by Dr. Fr. Luis
	Gomes, was conducted by Mr. Ramnath Gawde and Ms. Jofa Gonsalves, who
	shared techniques for developing engaging and well-structured stories. For
	children's literature, Mr. Chetan Acharya and Ms. Nayna Aradkar, under the

	coordination of Ms. Siddhi Gawas, trained participants in writing for young audiences, emphasizing simplicity and engagement. Dr. Hanumant Chopdekar, coordinated by Mr. Silvester Vaz, led the session on literary criticism and book reviews, focusing on developing analytical and evaluative writing skills.
	The workshop witnessed active participation from 70 students representing various North Goa colleges, along with six teachers. Students appreciated the insightful sessions and the opportunity to learn from experienced writers and scholars. Certificates were awarded to all participants during the valedictory session. The Vote of Thanks was delivered by Mr. Dharma Chodankar, who expressed gratitude to all contributors for the program's success. The event was effectively compered by Ms. Siddhi Gawas. This workshop was a meaningful initiative to enhance students' writing skills in Konkani literature, contributing to the preservation of Goa's rich literary and cultural heritage.
