Report	<p>The Department of BBA (Travel and Tourism) organised a study trip for the students of TY BBA (Travel and Tourism) on 13th August 25 to the Naval Aviation Museum in Goa, followed by a visit to King's Nest in Verna. The purpose of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure, enhance classroom learning, and create an opportunity to understand tourism resources and their relevance in the field of travel and tourism.</p> <p>The Naval Aviation Museum, a unique institution that showcases the history and growth of naval aviation in India. The museum features both outdoor and indoor galleries, offering a comprehensive view of naval aircrafts, equipment, and related heritage. The outdoor section displayed thirteen aircrafts, including planes and helicopters that had once served in defense operations. Aircraft engines and parts were also exhibited, giving visitors a glimpse into the technological dimensions of aviation.</p> <p>The indoor galleries, designed to resemble the interiors of INS Viraat, created a sense of being aboard an aircraft carrier. The Viraat Gallery and Vikrant Gallery contained large wooden models of these ships, symbolizing their significance in India's naval history.Students were able to observe displays related to naval</p>

	<p>armament, including bombs, torpedoes, autocannons, and sensors such as sonobuoys, which are used to detect underwater enemy targets.</p> <p>After the museum visit, the group proceeded to King's Nest in Verna, which offered a natural and relaxed environment. The site was filled with greenery and featured a variety of birds, including parrots ,Finches,Canary and Rosters along with a fountain that contained exotic fish. The calm surroundings allowed students to unwind, participate in recreational & team building games, and enjoy time together outside the classroom.</p>
