Mr. Vijay Talwar spoke about the formation of the Constituent Assembly, the various Articles, Parts, and Schedules of the Constitution, its achievements, and significant amendments made over the years. Ms. Pamela Fernandes discussed the Emergency—its causes, the government's response, the role of Jay Prakash Narayan, and the curtailment of citizens' rights during the period. The event concluded with a vote of thanks by Ms. Rashika Raikar. Outcomes: The talk highlighted the 75-year journey and evolution of the Indian Constitution. It emphasized the importance of core constitutional values like justice, liberty, and equality. The Emergency period was discussed as a dark phase that challenged democratic principles. The Constitution has adapted to changing times through over 100 amendments, showing its flexibility and strength. Number of Beneficiaries: A total of 80 students participated.
