Report	The Department of Konkani of St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, successfully organized Krutiranjana 3.0 on 10th and 11th October 2025. The event was open to all students of the college and witnessed an enthusiastic response with a total of 187 participants across various competitions. The event aimed to promote creativity, expression, and appreciation of Konkani art and literature among students. It provided a vibrant platform for participants to showcase their talents in writing, art, performance, and culinary skills. Krutiranjana 3.0 was coordinated by faculty members Ms. Pranita Redkar and Ms. Ankita Zambaulikar, under the guidance of Mr. Dharma Chodankar, Mr. Silvester Vaz, and Dr. Fr. Luis Gomes. The event was entirely managed and executed by the Second-Year SEC students of the Department of Konkani, who displayed exemplary leadership and teamwork throughout the two-day festival. The Chief Guest for the inaugural function was Ms. Megan D'Souza, alumna of the Department of Konkani and Assistant Editor at Prudent Media Goa, who inspired students with her address on the role of Konkani youth in media and cultural preservation. Fr. Antonio Salema, the Administrator of St. Xavier's College, graced the event with his presence and appreciated the efforts of the organizers and participants. Competitions were held in various categories such as Poem Writing, Article Writing, Story Writing, Poster Making, Sketching, Treasure Hunt, Traditional Goan Sweet Dish, Canvas Painting, Photography, Just a Minute (JAM), Fashion

	Show, and Dance. The response from students was overwhelming, reflecting their creative potential and appreciation for Konkani language and culture. Highlights included: Poem Writing: Kajal Vernekar secured the first place. Article Writing: Siddhi Chodankar won the top position. Story Writing: Vidhi Vengulkar stood first. Poster Making: Poonam Palyekar took the first place. Sketching: Poonam Palyekar again won the first prize. Traditional Goan Sweet Dish: Ayush Narvekar bagged the first prize. Canvas Painting: Sanghpriya Parsekar secured the top position. Photography: Vegan Costa stood first. JAM (Just a Minute): Morris Fernandes emerged as the winner. Fashion Show: Team Goencho Porzoll took the first prize. Dance Competition: Sarjana & Group bagged first place. Krutiranjana 3.0 served as a celebration of talent and creativity, blending traditional Goan artistry with modern forms of expression. It successfully fostered cultural appreciation and confidence among students while strengthening the visibility of Konkani as a vibrant academic and creative medium.
