Report	The Cell for Promoting Diversity & Inclusion (Divyangjan) of St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, organised a special outreach performance of the tiatr "Purple" on 5th October 2025 at St. Michael's Church, Taleigao, on the occasion of the parish feast. The event was coordinated by Nodal Officer Dr. Fr. Luis Gomes, who also served as the Writer and Director of the tiatr. The tiatr focused on the theme of inclusion of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), promoting awareness, empathy, and equality through the performing arts. It aimed to sensitize the community towards embracing diversity and respecting the abilities of every individual. A total of 37 students participated in the production — 14 actors, 14 singers, 2 musicians, and 7 backstage assistants. The stage setup was managed by Assoc.Prof. Mr. Conceicao De Souza and Asst. Prof. Mr. Lisvan Rodrigues, with several faculty members assisting in coordination and logistics. The performance at Taleigao drew an impressive audience of about 800 people, who appreciated the social relevance and artistic presentation. Earlier, the same tiatr had been awarded 1st Place at the 5th All Goa Intercollegiate/Higher Secondary Tiatr Competition 2025-26 organised by the Tiatr Academy of Goa, winning a total of 17 prizes for excellence in acting, music, direction, and script. The Taleigao show, however, was a non-competitive community outreach initiative undertaken by the Cell to promote inclusion and awareness among the wider public. The Cell for Promoting Diversity & Inclusion (Divyangjan) expresses heartfelt
