Report	St. Xavier's College, Mapusa organized an Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme on 20 th September 2025 aimed at promoting a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment at the college. The program opened with the singing of the college anthem, fostering a spirit of unity among students and faculty.
	A key highlight of the program was the presence of two esteemed guest speakers: Deputy Superintendent of Police (DySP), Goa, Mr. Wilson Cipriano D'Souza, and DySP Officer Mr. Braz Menezes. Both officers brought not only their law enforcement experience but also a strong commitment to student welfare and campus safety. Principal Ms. Ursula Barreto welcomed the guests and addressed the audience, reiterating the college's firm stance against ragging and its dedication to maintaining a healthy and secure academic environment.
	In his address, DySP D'Souza delivered an enlightening and comprehensive talk on the consequences of ragging. He provided detailed insights into the history, laws, Supreme Court judgments, and institutional policies that govern anti-ragging measures in educational

	institutions. His presentation included real-life cases and outcomes, underscoring the gravity of the issue. To further emphasize the message, a powerful and thought-provoking video was screened, illustrating the emotional and legal impact of ragging on both victims and perpetrators. The officers commended the college for zero cases of ragging over the years. The students of the college took an anti ragging pledge, hand on heart as a commitment against ragging. A token of appreciation was presented to DySP Mr. D' Souza by Fr. Antonio Salema, Administrator of St. Xavier's College.
	Following the presentation, an interactive Q&A session allowed students to voice their concerns andask questions. Both Mr. D'Souza and Officer Menezes responded offering legal perspectives, personal anecdotes, and actionable advice on how students can actively contribute to a ragging-free campus.
	The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Prema Rocha, the convenor of the Anti Ragging Squad. The initiative was well-received and effectively reinforced the college's ongoing commitment to ensuring a safe, respectful, and supportive learning environment for all.
