| Report | The History Department organized a field trip to heritage sites in North Goa to study their historical and cultural significance. The Surla Mosque reflects early Islamic presence and local cultural interaction. The Kudnem Jain Temple indicates the former influence of Jainism in Goa. The Arvalem Caves are associated with early Buddhist monastic activity. The Pariyem inscription is the oldest known inscription in Goa. The Shree Saptakoteshwar Temple at Narve highlights medieval temple patronage and continuity of Shaivite worship. The Corjuem Fort represents Portuguese defensive architecture and regional control strategies. |
