	3. To encourage critical thinking and rational inquiry by emphasising the constitutional directive of promoting scientific temperament.
	4. To inspire civic responsibility among students by connecting constitutional ideals to everyday life and contemporary challenges.
	Brief description

On 9th December 2025, Mr. Prasad Naik, Assistant Professor in Political Science at St. Xavier's College, Mapusa-Goa, addressed the FYBA students on the theme "Spirit of the Indian Constitution." The session was organised to deepen students' understanding of the foundational ideals enshrined in the Constitution of India and their relevance in contemporary society.

He emphasised liberty as the cornerstone of democratic life, enabling individuals to think, express, and act freely within the framework of law. He underscored equality as a non-negotiable principle, ensuring that every citizen, regardless of caste, creed, gender, or economic status, enjoys equal opportunities. He explained justice in its social, economic, and political dimensions, stressing the need for fairness in governance and protection of rights. He highlighted fraternity as the binding force of national unity, fostering mutual respect, solidarity, and harmony among diverse communities. He drew attention to the constitutional directive of promoting scientific temperament, rationality, and critical inquiry.

Outcomes:

- 1. Enhanced awareness among students about the spirit of the Indian Constitution and its guiding principles.
- 2. Strengthened commitment to rationality and evidence-based thinking through the adoption of a scientific temperament.
- 3. Motivated to act as responsible citizens, applying constitutional values in academic, social, and civic spheres.

Number of Beneficiaries: A total of 25 students participated in this enriching learning experience.
