Report	<p>The Economics Club of St. Xavier's College, Mapusa, organized an interactive event titled <i>Eco-scape Room</i>, which received an overwhelming response from 63 students across various disciplines. The event was conducted in two rounds, combining knowledge, teamwork, and problem-solving skills.</p> <p>The preliminary round was held on 5th February 2026 and saw the participation of 21 teams, each comprising of three students each. This round consisted of three stages. In the first stage, teams attempted a multiple-choice questionnaire that had to be completed within 10 minutes. Based on the number of correct responses, ten teams qualified for the second stage.</p> <p>In the second stage, participants were given a set of major historical events and were required to arrange them in chronological order. Once arranged correctly, a pattern of shapes was revealed, which the teams had to carefully memorize for the next stage. The third stage involved a bottle-flip challenge. A member from each team had to successfully flip a bottle, pick up the first pattern shape, and arrange the shapes in the correct sequence from memory. At the end of this stage, four teams advanced to the final round.</p> <p>The final round was conducted on 7th February 2026. Each qualifying team was assigned a room containing a series of clues and puzzles that had to be solved collaboratively in order to "escape" from the room. After a closely contested and exciting round, Mr. Anish Surya Goltekar, Ms. Aishwarya Degaonkar, and Ms. Tanisha Shirodkar (M.A. Psychology Part I) secured first place. The runners-up were Ms. Natasha Narvekar, Ms. Linnes Rodrigues, and Ms. Megan Gomes (TYBA Psychology), all students of St. Xavier's College, Mapusa.</p>

	<p>The event concluded with a prize distribution ceremony followed by a Vote of Thanks delivered by the Secretary of the Economics Club, Ms. Minoshka Fernandes.</p> <p>Overall, <i>Eco-scape Room</i> proved to be an engaging and enriching learning experience that was highly appreciated by both participants and faculty members</p>
