This was followed by the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries, symbolising the radiance of knowledge and the spark of imagination that the event seeks to inspire among participants.

Administrator Fr. Antonio Salema addressed the gathering with an uplifting message, encouraging students to embrace gratitude and mindfulness in their pursuits.
