Report	<p>The Public Speaking and Oratory Club of St. Xavier’s College, Mapusa, organized a session titled ‘From Campus to PM’s Forum: A Viksit Bharat Young Leader Speaks’, on 28th January 2026 in Class 326 from 11:15 am to 12:00 pm. The session aimed to inspire students by bridging campus experiences with high-level national forums focused on governance and public policy.</p> <p>The speaker was Mr. Shivang Shirodkar, a TYBSc Physics student at St. Xavier’s College, Goa and a BSc student in Data Science & Programming at IIT Madras. Shivang was one of 25 Prime Minister Presenters chosen from over 3,000 participants at the Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue held at Bharat Mandapam.</p> <p>Dr. Prema Rocha, mentor of the club, commended Mr. Shirodkar and encouraged the 22 students present to explore how purposeful public speaking can open doors to bigger opportunities beyond campus.</p> <p>In his session, Shivang shed light on the rigorous national selection process, which involved essay submission, presentation preparation, and speaking before an accomplished panel — culminating in a presentation to the Prime Minister where he shared his ideas on Fit Bharat, Hit Bharat.</p> <p>He shared valuable insights into pitching ideas effectively to influential panels, covering broad topics such as diplomacy, sports, education, and nation-related issues. He offered practical tips on maintaining panel engagement, such as strategically intriguing the listener and eliciting thoughtful questions to generate interest.</p> <p>The session wrapped up with an open floor for questions and discussion, during which the audience raised queries on censorship, sought further elaboration on the ideas presented to the Prime Minister, and engaged with him about his overall experience and advice for aspiring policymakers.</p> <p>Students left the session with enhanced clarity on national-level public speaking platforms, actionable strategies for engaging high-profile panels, and stronger motivation to pursue leadership opportunities.</p>
