

# FACES OF POWER: LEADERS OF INDEPENDENT INDIA

## (ROLE PLAY)

### Rules:

1. Each participant represents one Indian political leader after 1947.
2. The participant must dress or present themselves in a way that reflects the leader.
3. The role-play should highlight:
  - Leader's ideology
  - His Major contributions
  - His Important decisions or policies
1. Participants should speak in the first person, as if they are the leader.
2. The use of brief quotes, slogans, or famous speeches by the leader is encouraged.
3. Props or simple visuals may be used, but no elaborate stage setup.
4. Maintain historical accuracy.
5. No parody, mockery, or derogatory representation of leaders will be permitted.
6. Performance duration: 4-5 minutes
7. Languages: English, Konkani and Hindi
8. Judges' decision will be final

### Judging Criteria:

- Understanding of the leader and historical context -10
- Accuracy of facts and ideas -10
- Creativity and presentation- 10
- Dialogue delivery/role immersion- 10
- Costume/props -10



8. **Judging Criteria:** Creativity, relevance to theme, clarity of message, and overall presentation.
9. **Respectful Content:** No offensive, derogatory, or inaccurate material.
10. **Judges' decision will be final**
11. **Time allotted: 10:30 am - 1:00 pm**
