Report	<p>The Department of Economics at St. Xavier's College, Mapusa in association with IQAC conducted a 30- hour Certificate Course for SYBA Economics Major students titled 'Choices, Costs and Markets: Microeconomics Unlocked'. The Course was divided into two parts. The first part covered the first two modules and was conducted from 20.8.2025 to 26.9.2025. The second part covered the remaining two modules and was conducted from 2.1.2026 to 31.1.2026. The Certificate Course was designed to align with aligning with the Sustainable Development Goal of Quality Education (Goal 4)</p> <p>The Certificate Course in Microeconomics served as an introductory or preparatory course for the students who may not have had a strong background in Microeconomics or who needed a refresher before tackling more advanced topics. Its objectives included:</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Familiarization with fundamental Microeconomic concepts like utility, opportunity costs, consumer equilibrium, etc. 2. Understanding and interpreting economic indicators such as prices, costs, profits and revenue and their implications for the economy 3. Introduction to basic Microeconomic Models including Circular Flow of Income Model, Monopoly Model, Indifference Curve Model and others. 4. Linking Theory to current economic events and policy decisions. 5. Building Analytical Skills for microeconomic data and trends <p>Outcomes:</p> <p>At the end of the Course they were able to</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
