Report	<p>Nine students of MA Part 1 participated in the Career Conclave 2026, organised by the Office of the Commissioner, Labour & Employment in association with the Regional Employment Exchange and Model Career Centre, Panaji. The two-day conclave was held on 30th and 31st January 2026 at the Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium and brought together students, professionals, and career experts from across the state.</p> <p>The conclave was inaugurated in the presence of distinguished dignitaries, including Dr. Pramod Sawant, whose address emphasised the importance of skill development, self-employment, and youth empowerment in today’s competitive landscape. The programme was structured around the themes of Career Guidance & Counselling (Day 1) and Skill Development & Self-Employment (Day 2).</p> <p>Day 1 featured sessions such as “Mastering Skills of 21st Century for Corporate Success” and “Unleash Your Potential,” focusing on corporate readiness, communication, and personal growth. Day 2 highlighted entrepreneurship and informed career choices through sessions like “Ignite the Future – Entrepreneurship Skills,” a panel discussion on “Passion vs. Profession: How to Choose the Right Path,” and an awareness session on Government Schemes for Startups and Self-Employment. The conclave also included Q&A segments and dedicated career counselling clinics offering one-to-one and small group guidance.</p> <p>The MA students actively engaged with speakers, panelists, and career counsellors, gaining practical insights into employability, professional adaptability, and emerging opportunities. Exposure to motivational speakers, corporate trainers, and entrepreneurship mentors broadened their understanding of diverse career pathways beyond conventional roles.</p> <p>Overall, the Career Conclave 2026 proved to be an enriching and forward-looking experience. It enabled students to reflect on their aspirations, align their skills with industry expectations, and explore structured support systems available for career advancement and self-employment initiatives.</p>
