Report

a) Objectives

The primary objectives of the Cyber Conclave were to enhance awareness about cyber crime, cybersecurity, and cyber law among students, to provide insights into the legal framework governing digital spaces in India, to educate participants on protecting themselves from cyber threats, and to inspire students to consider careers in cybersecurity and cyber law. The event aimed to bridge the gap between technical knowledge and legal understanding of cybersecurity issues.

b) Description

The Cyber Conclave was conducted on 17th December 2025, at St. Xavier's Seminar Hall. The event featured an expert talk by Adv. Eeshan Usapkar, a distinguished lawyer, trainer, world-record holder, and one of India's most dynamic cyber law experts. The session covered critical topics including cyber crime, cybersecurity practices, and the legal framework governing digital activities in India.

Adv. Usapkar provided comprehensive insights into various types of cyber crimes, preventive measures, and the legal recourse available to victims. The session was designed to be accessible to students from all academic streams, ensuring that technical jargon was explained in layman's terms while maintaining the depth necessary for those with technical backgrounds.

The conclave was coordinated by Avinash Fernandes (Event Coordinator, Cyber Club) under the mentorship of Ms. Prajoti Chimulkar (Club Mentor), with support from Ms. Ursula Barreto (Officiating Principal) and Fr. Antonio Salema (Administrator).

The interactive session included a question-answer segment where participants engaged with the resource person on practical scenarios, legal implications of common online activities, and emerging cyber threats. The conclave successfully created awareness about the importance of digital safety and the legal dimensions of cybersecurity.

c) Results

The Cyber Conclave successfully enhanced participants understanding of cyber crime, cybersecurity, and cyber law. Students and faculty gained practical knowledge about protecting themselves from digital threats and understanding their legal rights and responsibilities in the digital space. The event contributed significantly to the Cyber Club's mission of promoting cybersecurity awareness across the campus. Participants demonstrated increased awareness of the legal framework governing digital activities and expressed interest in further exploring cybersecurity and cyber law as potential career paths. The session effectively bridged the gap between technical cybersecurity knowledge and legal understanding, providing a holistic perspective on digital safety.
