	<p>St. Xavier's College, Mapusa organized a cyber safety awareness session titled "Cyber Safety for Students – Protecting our digital world, securing our future" on 9th March 2026 at 12:00 pm in the College Seminar Hall in association with the Gender Champions and Cyber Club. The aim of the session was to create awareness among students about cyber crime and the importance of staying safe in the digital world. The resource persons, Mr. Sahil Awasthi, Cyber Yoddha, Goa Police, and Advocate Sunil Loran, were welcomed by Professor Prajoti Chimulkar, Mentor of the Cyber Club, Male Gender Champion Jenish Edwin, and Female Gender Champion Sheronne Dias.</p> <p>Mr. Sahil Awasthi explained the meaning of cyber crime in simple words and described how cyber attacks happen through fake links, phishing messages, fraud calls, and unsafe websites. He shared real-life examples to make students understand how people become victims of cyber crime. He also demonstrated websites and online tools that help in identifying cyber threats and showed how to verify whether a website is safe or fake.</p> <p>Advocate Sunil Loran then spoke about the safety measures that should be taken if someone becomes a victim of cyber crime. He explained the proper procedure for filing cyber complaints and informed students about the importance of reporting cyber incidents immediately to the cyber cell or through official online portals. He also guided students on what should and should not be done once cyber attacked. The session was very informative and</p>

	<p>interactive and helped students understand the importance of responsible use of technology. At the end of the session, the members of the Cyber Club presented a potted plant as a token of appreciation to the resource persons. Professor Prajoti Chimulkar delivered the vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the speakers and everyone involved in organizing the programme. The session concluded at 1:30 pm, followed by a group photograph.</p>
