a) Objectives	
<p>The primary objectives of the talk on “Cyber Crime, Crime Prevention and Cyber Law” were to educate students about their legal rights in the digital domain, enhance understanding of cyber crimes and their legal implications, provide knowledge about staying legally safe online, and promote awareness about legal recourse available to victims of cyber crimes. The session aimed to empower students with practical legal knowledge relevant to their daily digital interactions and to foster a culture of legal awareness in the increasingly digital landscape.</p>	
b) Description	
<p>The Talk on Cyber Security Law was conducted on 12th January 2026 at St. Xavier's Seminar Hall. This event was organized by the Cyber Club in collaboration with the Legal Aid Society of V. M. Salgaocar College of Law and the District Legal Services Authority, North Goa. The collaborative approach brought together legal expertise and</p>	

technical knowledge to provide comprehensive insights into cyber security from a legal perspective.

The session focused on three key themes: knowing your rights in the digital space, understanding various cyber crimes and their legal definitions, and learning how to stay legally safe while navigating online platforms. Representatives from the legal institutions delivered expert presentations covering topics such as data privacy rights, digital evidence, cyber defamation, online fraud, identity theft, and the legal framework governing digital transactions in India.

The event attracted over 80 participants from various academic streams, demonstrating the universal relevance of cyber security law in today's digital age. The talk was structured to be accessible to students without legal backgrounds, using practical examples and case studies to illustrate complex legal concepts.

The event was coordinated by Avinash Fernandes (Event Coordinator, Cyber Club) under the mentorship of Ms. Prajoti Chimulkar (Club Mentor), with support from Ms. Ursula Barreto (Officiating Principal) and Fr. Antonio Salema (Administrator). The session included an interactive question-answer segment where participants engaged with legal experts on practical scenarios and preventive measures.

c) Results

The talk successfully enhanced participants understanding of cyber security law and their legal rights in the digital domain. Students gained practical knowledge about identifying cyber crimes, understanding legal recourse available to victims, and adopting legally compliant online practices. The collaboration with legal institutions provided authoritative insights into the legal framework governing digital activities in India. Participants demonstrated increased awareness of their responsibilities and rights as digital citizens. The event contributed significantly to the Cyber Club's mission of promoting comprehensive cybersecurity awareness that encompasses both technical and legal dimensions. The partnership between technical and legal institutions established a model for future collaborative awareness programs that address cybersecurity holistically.
