Report	Objectives: The session aimed to create awareness about the Prime Minister's Internship Scheme (PMIS), a flagship initiative of the Government of India under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs that seeks to provide youth with meaningful workplace exposure through structured internships in leading companies and organizations. Brief description: Prof. Blanche Mascarenhas explained the objectives, eligibility criteria, benefits, and internship opportunities available under the scheme. Students were informed that the internships are offered for 6 or 9 months and provide financial assistance of ₹9,000 per month, along with a one-time incidental grant of ₹6,000, subject to the scheme guidelines. Informative videos were screened to explain the registration process on the PMIS portal, profile creation, internship search, and online application procedure. Students were encouraged to regularly visit the portal, as internship opportunities are posted on a rolling basis and each opportunity has a specific application deadline. At the end of the session, Prof. Blanche Mascarenhas introduced the internship coordinators for the various academic streams and advised students to approach their respective coordinators for any guidance or assistance regarding registration, applications, and other PMIS-related queries. Outcomes: The session concluded with students scanning the registration QR code for the future and an appeal made to students to actively utilize the opportunities offered under the PMIS to
