Report	Continuing with a long-standing tradition of the Physics Department, Ms. Lorelli Travasso (a recently passed-out student) delivered an 'Alumna Talk', to the students of the 2026-2027 TYBSc batch and SYBSc (Physics-Minor course) on 20th June 2026. The Talk was organized with the objective of sharing insights and experiences in navigating the academic challenges of the Final Year of graduation. At the outset, Prof. Nelson Lobo welcomed the Resource Person Ms Lorelli Travasso and introduced her to the students. After the introduction, Prof. Lawrence recused himself in order to permit a free and frank interaction between the Resource Person and the students. In her Talk, Ms. Franco shared her journey as a student of the Physics Department. She also detailed her experiences as a TYBSc student. Initially, she addressed the SYBSc students, encouraging and urging them to seriously ponder upon their goals and career choices. She provided the TYBSc students with a detailed overview of the courses of the Final Year of graduation. Even though the curriculum structure, under NEP, is different from that of the CBCS, she said that the contents of most courses are largely similar. She provided the students with tips to prepare for the examinations. She strongly urged them to study regularly,

	clear their doubts, write up their journals, and not to leave things until the last moment. She also shared her experiences about the Practical examinations and Project Viva. Towards the end of the Talk, Ms. Lorelli Travasso briefed the students about entrance tests and competitive examinations. She again stressed the importance of diligent preparation. She urged the students to approach life and examinations with a positive mindset and advised them to take setbacks in their stride. She also advised the students to take part in the various co-curricular activities conducted by the College. This helps in developing latent talents and moulding a well-rounded personality, she said. She strongly exhorted the students to continue the established traditions of the College and to do well in their examinations. The Talk was followed by a Question-n-Answer session wherein students raised various queries. The same were answered by Ms. Lorelli Travasso.
