Report	As part of the subject Cultural Heritage of Goa, a field trip was organised to explore and understand the cultural, historical, religious, and architectural heritage of Goa. We left Mapusa at 8:00 a.m. and began our journey to the first destination, Goa Chitra. Our next destination was Old Goa Church, one of the historic churches of Goa. We visited the church to learn about its historical importance and observe its impressive architecture. We saw the old structure, detailed architectural features, and the traditional design that reflects the Portuguese influence on Goa.

	The visit helped us understand the religious and cultural significance of the church and the importance of Old Goa as a major heritage area. The field trip provided us with an opportunity to learn about Goa beyond the classroom. By visiting these heritage sites, we were able to observe traditional artefacts, religious architecture, historical monuments, and cultural practices directly.
